The Bear ministry will meet on Monday, Jan. 28 at 9:30 a.m. in the multi-purpose room. All are welcome!


The Red & Pink Hat Ladies will be having their 2019 planning session and potluck on Tuesday, Feb. 5 at 11 a.m. at the church building.

"Twelve" John 6:10-14

In the past few months, I have given a lot of thought as to how we might press forward into another year or so. Although I did not incorporate "Sow. Grow. Produce" into as many lessons as I had originally hoped. I still think the theme and the biblical concepts that lie at its foundation served us guite well. The new theme, a theme I would like to incorporate for two years, is "Twelve". As has been pointed out many times, there are certain numbers that are repeated time and again in the biblical literature: forty, twelve, and seven are three we are very familiar with. I can't say exactly what made me think of "twelve", except that one day while driving to visit a member, I began to think about the disciples and what a diverse group of men they were. This theme is not a theme on the number 'twelve', but what the number twelve references. Twelve sons. Twelve tribes. Twelve disciples. Twelve baskets. Twelve years. Twelve Stones. Twelve Fruits. Over the next two years, once every two months, we will focus on our theme (if you are keeping up, that is twelve total lessons). In our pursuit for holiness, with our theme as a conduit, my prayer is that God will multiply our spiritual food, as he multiplied the loaves for those seated to listen to him, "They picked up what was left over, twelve full baskets" (Matthew 14:20).
