The Shepherd Prophet

Amos 5:14-15

Amos has a message of judgment for the waning kingdoms of Israel and Judah: "Surely the Lord God does nothing unless He reveals His secret counsel to His servants the prophets. A lion has roared! Who will not fear? The Lord God has spoken! Who can but prophesy? (Amos 3:7-8)". The prophets had come and the people had attempted to silence them because rarely does a prophet come to applaud our efforts. There is a threefold word from Amos, "Seek the Lord that you may live" (5:4, 6, 14). Amos helps them define what seeking Him looks like, "Let justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream" in contrast to empty rituals (5:18-24). There is little encouragement in Amos' message, even though twice he stands between God and the people (7:1-6). God's word will become scarce, and God will seek the people out for destruction, "except I will not utterly destroy the house of Jacob" (9:8). Like the prophecies of Joel, God sends these calamities as punishment and as a way to prompt repentance, "yet you did not return to me" (4:6, 8, 9-11). Let us make a commitment to not find ourselves in such a place or, when in such a place, to turn quickly to Him. What good can come from ignoring the discipline of God?
