Servants and Stewards  
1 Cor 4:7

Paul's focus is two-fold. On one hand are the apostles--those like himself. On the other hand, are the Corinthians. Paul is continuing to defend his trustworthiness as a steward, and he is doing so as a living example (alongside Apollos) for the sake of the Corinthians. The Corinthians must have been "passing judgment" about Paul, but they were in over their heads in doing so. They had no right to pass judgment on what they had received as if they were originators. Paul asks, "What do you have that you did not receive?" He demonstrates through his own ill treatment that the Corinthians benefitted from his degradation. In fact, he calls himself their father in the Gospel and calls on them to imitate him. Interspersed in this section of 1 Corinthians are some axiomatic statements-- statements that encapsulate and transcend the specific Corinthian situation. These statements are that which we should also consider. The Lord examines us and our work (4:4). It is required of stewards to be found trustworthy (4:2). What I have, I received (at least, in part) from someone else (4:7). In many cases, someone else suffers so that I do not have to (4:9-14). These are natural corollaries of the Gospel.
